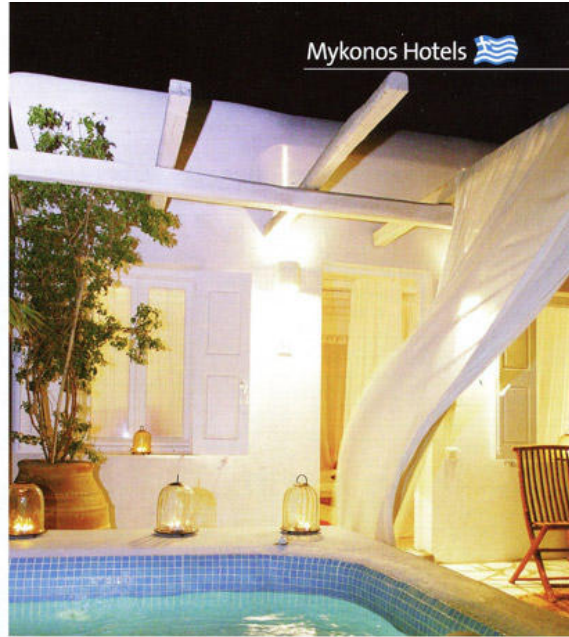



Prefer the reclusive side of glamour? You can find it in Mykonos

This stylish family-owned resort of 24 double rooms and suites is a favourite with those looking for a sumptuous hideaway on the party island. The Ostraco is located close to Chora, up on a hill in Drafaki, offering spectacular views to the Aegean sea. Aromatic flowering courtyards, shady pergolas and two traditional chapels make the suites ideal for wedding ceremonies and honeymooners. For those hunting a little more action, a pool with pool bar and ground chess set provide gentle entertainment. Each of the rooms is individually designed and decorated - some with hydromassage cabins - combining traditional Mykonian and Greek furnishings with contemporary minimalist design; so it is tempting to come and visit here on 24 occasions, to try out all the rooms!
